## **Psychology**

The London School of Economics (LSE) is No 1 out of the 115 universities in our Psychology table. It is the third year running that LSE has topped the ranking, where its eminence is secured

with the top research rating by a clear margin, based on our analysis of the Research Excellence Framework 2021, as well as rates of student satisfaction which place the LSE third for teaching quality and fourth for the wider experience. St Andrews, in second place overall, is top for graduate prospects and one of only 11 universities where at least 80% of graduates were in highskilled jobs or postgraduate study 15 months after their degrees. While the older institutions dominate the upper ranks of the main table, Cumbria (in 59th place overall) outdoes all others for students' evaluation of teaching quality, followed by Wales Trinity (32nd). Cumbria also leads for the wider student experience, followed by Bath (fifth overall). Conversely, Northampton gets the lowest ratings for both of these student-led metrics and places 115th overall.

Most undergraduate programmes are accredited by the British Psychological Society, which ensures that key topics are covered, but the clinical and biological content of courses varies considerably. Some courses require maths and/or biology A-levels among three high grade passes, while others are much less demanding. The contrast is evident in the table, with 35 universities averaging at least 144 points in the UCAS tariff (equivalent to three As at A-level) and another 24 falling below 110 points.

Professor Peter Fonagy, head of the Division of Psychology and Language Sciences, UCL explains that "Psychologists ask fundamental questions about consciousness, memory, language and other aspects of people that are not yet fully understood. They address mental health issues that pervade society, from day-to-day wellbeing to treatment of clinical disorders. They use their knowledge of how to change human behaviour to respond to global challenges such as climate change, pandemic disease and artificial intelligence."

The numbers of psychology students accepted onto courses grew by 50% in the decade up to 2018 and have continued their incline more recently. Even after a 3% decline in 2023, psychology still received over 126,000 applications and 26,775 new students were accepted onto courses. Immediate career prospects are unlikely to be what is attracting so many students: psychology ranks 67th in our 70-subject employment table, based on only half of graduates being employed in professional-level jobs and/or studying within 15 months of finishing their degrees. The proportion working in "lowskilled" jobs at this point after graduation (31.9%) is not far below the proportion that had secured full-time professional jobs (34.2%). Explaining this, commentators within psychology suggest that graduates may benefit from a more gradual transition into complex psychological roles, such as those involving direct work with clients and service users, and that experience gained in nongraduate jobs can help to build confidence and serve as stepping stones to putting their universityacquired skills into practice. Average graduate salaries of £23,000 rank the subject =61st out of 70.

## Radiography

"There are two radiography disciplines – diagnostic and therapeutic," explains Dr Jane Harvey-Lloyd, associate professor in diagnostic radiography, School of Medicine, University of Leeds. "Diagnostics uses a range of imaging modalities to diagnose illness and disease. Therapeutics uses methods like ionising radiation to treat mainly cancer. New technology is continuously emerging, providing new ways to diagnose and treat illness and disease. If you are considering a dynamic career that combines cutting-edge technology with caring for others, radiography is for you."

Diagnostic courses usually involve two years of studying anatomy, physiology and physics, followed by further training in oncology, psycho-social studies and other modules. Candidates need at least one science A-level, or equivalent, usually biology. Graduates of radiography can rest assured that professional-level work is on the horizon soon after university, with radiography invariably featuring in the top 10 of our employment ranking – where it is up four places to rank fourth this year. Exeter, Leeds, Robert Gordon, Canterbury Christ Church, Teesside and Derby achieved perfect 100% graduate prospects scores, due to every one of their radiography graduates being employed in professional jobs and/or postgraduate study within 15 months. Only one university, St George's, London (now City St George's), had fewer than nine in ten graduates achieving the desired career outcomes at the same point of survey, and it still tallied a respectable 84% rate. For pay, radiography compares less strongly with other subjects, but is comfortably in the upper half of our 70-subject salaries index.

For the third consecutive year, Glasgow Caledonian leads our dedicated ranking for radiography degrees, now in its 12th edition having previously been listed among "Subjects Allied to Medicine" in the *Guide*. It does best in both measures derived from the National Student Survey (NSS): teaching quality and the wider undergraduate experience and its radiography entrants average the highest entry standards. Former winner Leeds takes fourth

place this year, while Queen Margaret, Edinburgh is runner-up for the second year in a row. Strength in research is unbeaten at Keele (=14th overall) which achieved the top scores in the recent Research Excellence Framework 2021, followed by Leeds. Our National Student Survey analysis shows the two universities of St George's, London and City – which have since merged to form City St George's University – to share second and third place for teaching quality and the wider experience. Conversely, Plymouth comes bottom for the student experience and Keele is at the foot of the table for teaching quality.
